

MCPHERSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONER'S PROCEEDINGS
SPECIAL MEETING – FEBRUARY 18, 2026

The McPherson County Board of Commissioners met as per adjournment of February 11, 2026, for a Special Meeting. Notice of meeting having been posted the McPherson County Courthouse, Prairie Hills Café and Neal Oil, all locations in Tryon, NE. Notice was posted 5 days prior to meeting. The sole purpose of the meeting was to approve a claim for the purchase of a 2020 Fontaine Traverse HT Drop Deck Trailer. The meeting was called to order at 9:15 AM by Chairman Bryant. Members John Bryant and Jeffrey Arensdorf were present. Arensdorf made a motion to excuse Commissioner Brett Nason who was absent. Bryant seconded. Voting Aye: Arensdorf and Bryant. Voting Nay: None. Also present were Kathy Hoberg, Kerri Kramer, Ed Black and Ron Munson. Bryant noted the Open Meetings Law which is posted on the North wall of the courtroom.

Arensdorf moved to approve the minutes of the last meeting as presented. Bryant Seconded. Voting Aye: Arensdorf and Bryant. Voting Nay: None.

Arensdorf made a motion to approve claim #26020053 for the purchase of a 2020 Fontain Hydraulic Tail Lowboy Trailer. Purchase price \$54,900.00, to be paid from the Inheritance Fund with re-imbursement from the Road Fund. Bryant seconded the motion. Voting Aye: Arensdorf and Bryant. Voting Nay: None.
